Bari, 28 - 29 November 2024



Rationale

The Italian Ministry of Health has identified the fight against antimicrobial resistance (AMR) as one of the three priorities on its G7 Presidency agenda. AMR is the main theme of discussion during this last in-person event of the G7 health track in Bari.

Antimicrobial resistance represents one of the most urgent and complex challenges of our times, a threat that knows no boundaries and requires a commitment from everyone.

This event is intended to act as a bridge between the commitments announced at global level and the strategies undertaken at national level, placing at its centre the One Health approach.

Representatives of institutions, civil society and the scientific world will discuss the perspectives related to interdisciplinary collaboration, research and innovation to effectively address the emergency of AMR.

The plenary session of the event will be preceded, on the morning of Thursday 28th November, by thematic workshops that will focus on national policies related to AMR, on the role and contribution of the health workforce and the scientific community, and on aspects connected to innovation and technology transfer.

The G7 event will be concluded on Friday the 29th November with a high-level meeting, reserved only to G7 members, invited countries and International Organisations. During this session the future perspectives for global cooperation to combat AMR will be discussed.
